The Pollution Remediation Section of the Department of Environmental Resources Management (PRS/DERM) has reviewed the above-referenced product submittal application. Based upon the information provided, the PRS/DERM has no objection to the use of this product for cleanup of oil and chemical spills, provided that all applicable federal (e.g., Occupational Safety and Health Administration, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act), state (e.g., Chapter 62-770, Florida Administrative Code) and local (e.g., Chapter 24, Code of Miami-Dade County) regulations are meet.

Be advised that this product must be completely removed from the environment and properly disposed. A PRS/DERM approval letter must be obtained prior to disposal at one of the county-owned landfills (North Dade Landfill, NDLF, or South Dade Landfill, The results of laboratory analyses using USEPA Method 1311 (Toxicity Characteristic Leaching Procedure), which demonstrate that the waste is not hazardous, must be submitted to PRS/DERM with the approval request. Department of Solid Waste Management, however, is the final authority for disposal at the NDLF and SDLF. Sylvester Pates (NDLF, (305) 628-4295) and Larry Adams (SDLF, (305) 258-2830) may be contacted for more information regarding disposal at the county-owned landfills.

Requests for use of Bio-Matrix for remediation purposes must be submitted on a sitespecific basis as part of the remedial action plan. A copy of this letter should be provided in the RAP to facilitate the review process.
